

Family Group Conferencing

This workshop provides individuals with foundational knowledge and basic skills for facilitating restorative circles with families and provides experiential learning in the Family Group Conferencing, also known as Family Group Decision Making process.

Training objectives are:

- o to learn how circle process forms a foundational restorative approach for addressing issues of concern in families, schools and communities
- o to examine components and techniques of the facilitator (circle keeper) role for creating a culturally safe environment and modeling empowerment-based strategies
- to deepen our collective understanding regarding the intention of family group conferencing for families dealing with current or potential child protection issues
- o to gain competency in planning and facilitating Family Group Conferences and other circles
- to increase understanding of historical impacts and transgenerational trauma for Indigenous peoples and how the FGC process can activate the village for a child
- to understand how this process offers an invitation to family healing and decolonization therapy for Indigenous families
